<p>1650</p>	<p>The members of the MWDBd. Addressed the meeting on the subject of ditch New Rd/ Old Rd. Problems of pipework explained which had resulted after development of housing. To resolve problem a complete scheme would be needed funded by riparian owners & ERYC & overseen by MWDBd. The board feel that moral responsibility lies with ERYC because problems caused by planning actions. After public meeting some years ago residents asked MWDBd to approach ERYC to come together with them to solve. Nothing came of this. Mr Clerk said it would not be possible to get large machinery down ditch because of gardens, fences etc. On enquiry Cllrs informed that levels are too low for water to be diverted in opposite direction. If a complaint was received by MWDBd from a resident they would try and solve it firstly by discussion.</p> <p>Proposed Cllr Evans Sec. Cllr Chearman that the Parish Council take up the matter with ERYC Planning Dept. All in favour. The 3 members from MWDBd were thanked for their attendance.</p>

In addition there will be instant response officers for 999 calls, there will also be serious crime investigators. The Police are working with local authorities ER has an effective committees for Safe Communities, (1500) Parishes. There are anti social behaviour workers in the ER.
