

MINUTES OF MEEING OF HOLME ON SPALDING MOOR PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON WEDNESDAY 21st JUNE 2006 AT 7.30P.M. IN THE METHODIST CHURCH HALL.

<p>1638 MINUTES</p>	<p>Minutes of previous meeting having been circulated were approved and signed. (Line 4 min. 1627 was amendment to mins. 19/4/06 & had been approved 17/5/06)</p>
<p>1639 MATTERS ARAISING</p>	<p>1. Information received from ERYC re. double hatted members & code of conduct for P. Cllrs sitting on other Village committees read. In many communities it will be appropriate to participate in council discussion & decisions relating to the relevant body & to vote. However if there is a genuine conflict between the interests of the P. Council & the body on matters of principle or allocation of significant public funds or planning applications & members of the public would think your close involvement is likely to prejudice your judgement an interest should be declared.</p> <p>2. Police Pocklington Neighbourhood Panel Representative from P. Cll. Cllr. Evans was previous appointee & is willing to serve again. Cllr. Wild felt matter was not being dealt with fairly and withdrew his request to be considered. Prop. Cllr. Engall Sec. Cllr. Dowson that Cllr. Evans be re-elected. Votes 5 for 3 abstentions. Carried. Chairman pointed out that meetings are open to anyone to attend 7 participate. Next meeting 26/07/06 HOSM Village Hall 7.00p.m.</p> <p>3. Printed details of S. Atkinsons work & charges for 2005/06 distributed. Cllr. Shields queried the service being provided. Cllrs. Shields & Wild commented that some control from P. Cll. Should be in place to justify spending public money. Discussion took place on whether or not ERYC would provide a better service. Cllr. Smith thought that quality of work by contractors employed by ERYC this year was not up to standard of previous years. Clerk to write to ERYC & complain at quality of work, Litter not collected prior to cutting & missing out certain locations. Question arose as to whether or not P. Cll. Should be paying for verge along Convent Wall. Clerk to contact ERYC re. this & ask for clarification of who owns strip between footway & wall. Clerk to write & ask ERYC for more regular street sweeping & weed spraying on footways. Old Road & Back Lane in particular are very bad.</p> <p>4. Chief Insp. Geenty has accepted invitation to attend P. Cll. Meeting to talk about proposed new Police mergers, he will be present at July 19th meeting.</p>

	<p>5. Clerk had made enquiries. Charging VAT for advertising in Parish Council Newsletter. P.Cll. Are not registered for VAT so tax not be charged. P. Cll. Is public body & receives appropriate forms for reclaiming of VAT charged to them.</p>

Letter from Dave Bragg ERYC, council are aware of need for repair of A641, funds for principal roads are held by Asset Management Group. Clerk to write to this department asking for action. 2. Passing place sign on Bailywood Lane will be renewed or repaired. 3. P. Clerk MWDBd. Letter re ditch Old Police House/ Red Lion. P.CLLRS are not satisfied with his response. MWDBd. Chairman to be invited to P.C. meeting to discuss matter with P. Councillors. Cllr. Shields asked what Ward Cllr. Has been doing about it. Cllr. Engall responded that she continually raises the matter. She said that Drainage Board has power to act & to reclaim expenses from riparian owners, MWDBd are ducking the issue. Cllr.
