1615 Minutes	Minutes of the previous meeting having been circulated were approved & signed.
1616 Matter arising.	<p>1. Letter from ERYC planning re. Gallymoor asbestos waste planning received and discussed. Holme on Spalding Moor Parish Council has not yet received notice of decision. No response to date to request for list of consultees . Cllr Shields said that application & approval decision are on website under Mkt. Weighton Town Council. He said that PDF document on website is locked in and can be read but not printed off. He further said that a source has informed him that asbestos has been tipped for some time at Gallymoor, when asked to give name to verify this statement he declined to do so. Other P. Cllrs said they had been refered in the past to alternative sites by Gallymoor staff & had paid for disposal at these other sites. Clerk to write to ERYC complaining about document being locked in , also complain that application is incorrectly listed under Mkt. Weighton Town Council & question legality of planning process because of this. Clerk to also send to ERYC sheets of petition by residents of HOSM against this planning approval.</p> <p>Cllr. Shields queried if Cllr Stephen King had been involved as consultant by Company who had sought this planning approval, other Parish Cllrs. Thought this unlikely.</p> <p>On query regarding closed meetings for discussing sensitive matters when press & public are asked to leave, meeting informed that this has to be made after a proposal & then a unanimous agreement of Parish Cllrs present.</p> <p>2. Letter received from Pond's Trust, an appointment will be made for Mr Roberts to visits Weir's Pond and give advice, Stephen Atkinson will be invited to attend this site visit.</p> <p>3. Letter from ERYC re. Howdenshire Rail Trail following complaints from Parish Council. They are taking the necessary action to remedy situation</p> <p>4. Sign of 1st World War removed from Barn on High St. Clerk has seen Mr Oliver who has it in safe keeping. Agreed that clerk will collect sign and Cllr Evens will arrange for it to be renovated, suggested it be placed in Village Hall when renovated, all agreed.</p>

Obnoxious odours from Messr Rewcastles reported last week on MW Common smell carried on westerly wind. Planning application is expected from Mr Rewcastle in June. 3. Cavill Bridge subsidence causing traffic hold-ups. P. Council noted that if bridge is totally closed at anytime parking problems in village centre need to be addressed. 4. Complaint received re. S. Atkinson bowing bits onto road, clerk to draw this to Stephens attention. 5. Query about who owns Enterprise to Rush Corner ditch 6. Tree lights pulled down on village green, this will be attended to 7. Car paking outside Select & Save, clerk to report to ERYC. 8. Cash card machine problems, there is big fraud drive reported in area 9. Bulmer Lane needs passing places and overgrowth of trees needs trimming back. Clerk to write to Highways & ask for action 10. Footpath 21 gate reported closed on occasions. Clerk to contact Mr Oliver and request access to be open at all times. 11. Rush Corner has excess of water after recent heavy rains. Clerk to contact D. Bragg. ERYC 12. Draft copies of Newsletter for May. Distributed. 13. A1079 group asked for volunteer from HOSM Parish Council. Cllr Shields offered last year but has been unable to attend . No one volunteered. 14. Land fill sites offering free compost at various sites in towns & villages in East Riding. HOSM is not one of these. 15. Clerk to also ask for more frequent gully cleaning. 16. East Riding News reported £2.6 million to be spent on footpaths in ER. 17. Complaint about dangerous condition of road surface, potholes and mud on road as well as poor state of verges Common Lane. Clerk to report to ERYC but as this is outside our parish to inform M. Weighton Town Council of this.
