<p>1605 Matters arising</p>	<p>1. Parish Plan. Chairman had attended P.P. meeting 14th March '06' & points on letter to Parish Council had been discussed.</p> <p>a. Litter bins request, location of present bins outlined for P.P. group. Parish Council will look at placing bin at Meadowfield when funds allow.</p> <p>b. Flashing signs to calm traffic. Noted that P. Council's request for these has been turned down in past as village has speed camera's. Clerk to write again asking for flashing lights to be installed.</p> <p>c. Parish Council monitors all public footpaths & reports as necessary, this is part of Parish Council duties. Rail trail has already been reported to ERYC & is being actioned upon.</p> <p>d. Noted that a meeting is to be held with Vicar re. old school as possible youth centre. Scout Headquarters to be used as Homework club.</p> <p>e. Walkway from Village Hall to School to rear of High Street properties was discussed by Parish Council, in view of necessity of buying land, surfacing of footpath & lighting, too costly. Footpath along High Street considered good & already widened opposite Rose Farm some time ago.</p> <p>f. Notice boards, there is already large Village Notice Board on Green. One at Runner End and one at Station Lane end would be beneficial, suggest that P.Plan group apply for grant which they have suggested is available.</p> <p>g. Skate Park to be situated on land at Moor End is not an option, Mrs McGarry has already been informed by the owners of land who are HOSM In Need & Education Charity, owners are not Church as stated in her letter to P. Council.</p> <p>h. Affordable housing suggestion noted.</p> <p>i. Holme in Bloom Competition Parish Council would welcome P.Plan group organising this if sufficient volunteers available.</p> <p>1/ Parish Council noted invitation to attend Talent Showcase on 31/03/06</p> <p>2/ Environment Agency letter in response to Cllr. <p>1609 Concurrent functions</p>	<p>Cllr. Wild raised the subject of double payments having circulated papers to Parish Cllrs. Clerk had contacted ERYC who confirmed the information given at the last meeting. The ERYC have a policy of Special Expenses which means that we do not pay for services provided by ERYC to other communities e.g. Cemeteries etc. These are charged to individual Parish Councils who use them as Special Expenses. Holme on Spalding Moor does not have any Special Expenses on the Council Tax Bills to residents.</p>
<p>1610 Cllrs. Reports</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Clerk to report bad state of surface of Howden Road. 2. Gully near 19 Old Road blocked, noted this has been attended to 14th March. 3. Enterprise ditch/Rush Corner filled with litter clerk to report to ERYC. 4. Cliffe Lane verges bad, also mud on road. Clerk to write again to ERYC. 5. Query re. Horses Fouling on Hawthorne Drive. Cllr Engall said rules for dog fouling do not apply to horses, inform resident to complain to police. 6. Potholes Baileywood Lane, Bulmer & Arglam Lanes, Clerk to report. 7. Standing water on Sands Lane. Clerk to ask ERYC to make inspection of lanes with regard to standing water. 8. ERYC green dog bag service is to continue. 9. Land fill site at Gallymoor is to be open for the public's use 7 days a week. 10. Water quality improvement work to begin in Holme on Spalding Moor week commencing 20th March. 11. Information re. police reorganisation, creation of an improved call system passed round for P.Cllrs to peruse. 12. Clerk to report drain cover opposite the Hollies sinking. 13. Clerk to write to Highways asking them to look at improving placement of road signs & speed limit signs on Market Weighton Road. Ask for these to be placed before the hill when approaching HOSM to give more warning of bend & speed limit as an improvement towards road safety. 14. Door on street light column at Castle Corner hanging off & wires displayed, clerk to report. 15. Rabbits at Weir's Pond & Churchyard, report noted. 16. State of Weir's Pond agrees should soon be addressed, there is excessive over-growth of rushes. Clerk produced information about Ponds Trust which she has on file. Clerk to write to this trust and ask for advice. 17. Cllr. Dowson presented a cheque in the sum of £82.20 which is the surplus of income over expenses from the Carols Night Christmas Fayre. Agreed this be sent to Mrs Fotheringham in order that she may purchase bulbs which will be passed on to Parish Plan Working Group for them to plant in the Autumn.
