11/11 Matters arising

- ✓ LEADER Rural Heritage Grants Workshop, the event has been organised by D Bullock and advertised in The Grapevine
- ✓ Old Lea, ownership transfer has been concluded
- ✓ Sotherans Plantation, waiting for enforcement action
- ✓ Community payback, waiting for the benches and bus shelter to be sanded and stained.
- ✓ Weirs pond, a meeting is to be arranged with BTCV
- ✓ Parish Online, the mapping software package has been ordered and password information circulated, Clerk to send out the information again
- ✓ Common land at Land of Nod, further letter received from C Laverack was noted
- ✓ Town Crier for the Land of Nod, John Parsons from Stoke on Trent has now withdrawn
- ✓ Town Crier for HOSM, it was **resolved** to hold a competition at Holme Feast and run an article in the July Grapevine. Clerk to advise the East Yorkshire Town Crier
- ✓ Designation of HOSM ie town versus village, information from ERNLLCA says that the Parish Council can designate itself a Town Council. It was **resolved** to discuss this issue after the May elections
- ✓ Gallymoor, problems of litter and smell were raised by Parish Councillors, the response from Gallymoor was not considered satisfactory and it was **resolved** to ask the Clerk to arrange a meeting on-site with the Environment Agency
- ✓ Back Lane and its designation as a gritting route, Parish Councillors again expressed concern that Back Lane is not a primary salting route. It was **resolved** to ask the Clerk to write to bus companies asking for letters of support
- ✓ Hedge on Bulmer Lane/Chestnut Drive fence, issues have been resolved

11/00408/PLF Erection of a new main entrance canopy to rear at The Kingfisher, Market Weighton Road for Enterprise Inns PLC, no comments

11/00371/PLF Erection of conservatory to rear at The Old Post House, 9 Old Road for Mr & Mrs Cowe, no comments

13/11 Planning decisions as advised by East Riding of Yorkshire Council

DC/10/05134/PLF Alterations and extensions including erection of a first floor extension to front, single storey extension to rear and conversion of garage and room above to form additional living accommodation at The Willows, Burse Lane for Mr & Mrs Breeden, granted

The Clerk is advised that the application for 23 affordable houses on Sands Lane has been deferred by the East Riding Council pending a site visit

Brian Reynolds the East Riding of Yorkshire Council Affordable Housing Officer has asked for comments on the lettings policy if the Sands Lane application is approved. The Parish Council discussed the lettings policy and **resolved** to ask for representation on the nominations and vetting committees. The wording of the policy was discussed and suggested amendments were agreed. Clerk will copy the reply to Parish Councillors with the minutes

14/11 Accounts, balances of £2611.97 current account, £6727.94 saver account

Cheques approved were £155.00 S Atkinson handyman, £96.00 P Wiles litter picker. A cheque issued at the January meeting was made out to the wrong payee, this was corrected (TG Sweepers)

Newsletter/copier year to date for 2010/11; Income £2320.04 Expenditure £2525.67

The Grapevine delivery in February will be accompanied by a community booklet on how to avoid being scammed, as this will involve extra work it was unanimously **resolved** to increase the delivery payment to £90, proposed D Bullock seconded M Johnson

15/11 Elvington bridge weight limit, an email from Bubwith Parish Council and reply from the East Riding Council officer were considered. The Parish Council supported the letter of objection to the weight limit as it was resulting in increased HGV traffic in HOSM

Clerk read out information reference the B1228 near the entrances to Ellerton village, this stretch of road will have a temporary road closure between 24 April and 6 June 2011 for resurfacing work to be carried out

16/11 Reports

- A Dowson reported that someone in the village is claiming that one of the new 'Council Houses' on Port Royal has been incorrectly let to someone from Leeds, Clerk will investigate and report back
- M Johnson reported that complaints had been made about parking on the pavement on High Street outside the old school, also reported problems with dropped drain covers
- E Smith reported that there was no truth to rumours that parking meters would be put in place in the Village Hall car park
- A Dowson reported that Sands Lane was still flooding and that the grips to take away water needed to be extended to the dyke
- D Engall reported that the East Riding of Yorkshire Council was committed to protecting front line services despite cuts in Government funding
- C Worrall reported that the work on preparing the A614 and A163 for resurfacing appears to have been concluded and asked when the resurfacing was to be done. Also reported that Cliffe Lane road surface was still a mess and suggested a site meeting with the Highways Department, also reported a problem traffic sign on the A163
