

**Minutes of the Holme on Spalding Moor Parish Council special meeting held on Wednesday 7 July 2010 in the Methodist Church Hall**

Public session

Mr Bainbridge spoke in favour of the planning application below saying that his family had been living in the temporary accommodation for over 3 years. An outline planning application had been passed and an application had been submitted for the reserved matters. The continued use of temporary accommodation was needed until this application was approved

62/10 Planning application

DC/10/02047/PLF Continued siting of temporary living accommodation in association with equestrian centre at Port Royal Equestrian Centre, Skiff Lane for Mrs Michelle Bainbridge. Parish Councillors commented that the business needed someone on site full time and that over 20 staff were employed. Parish Councillors supported the application by 4 votes to 1. D Engall observed the discussion but took no part

(NOTE at the meeting on 28/7/10 these minutes were amended to say "Parish Councillors supported the application by 4 votes to 0 with 1 abstention")

Clerk informed the meeting

1. The meeting with Steve Cook of the East Riding of Yorkshire Council planning department would need two hours, a date for this meeting to be decided at the meeting on 28 July
2. Three people have been nominated for the bye election
3. The planning application to remove condition two of the cemetery planning decision has been granted, no official confirmation has been received but D Engall informed the Clerk of the result
4. Clerk after speaking to the Chairman has invited Kerry Bradfield of Waste Recycling Group to the meeting on 28 July. This is to brief Parish Councillors on development plans at Gallymoor, D Engall informed that two wind turbines of 87metre height were planned and a public consultation meeting about the development plans was also planned for 23 July in the Village Hall
5. The affordable housing scheme consultation announced in The Grapevine has caused some concern with local residents and the Chairman has decided to hold a meeting between residents, Chevin Housing Association, East Riding of Yorkshire Council and Parish Councillors on Thursday 15 July 2010 at 7.30pm in the Methodist Church Hall. Clerk circulated a copy of a letter delivered to local residents plus comments on the letter by Chevin. Also distributed was a copy of the East Riding of Yorkshire Local Development Plan Selected Sites map and explanatory notes, this has been viewed by residents causing confusion with the affordable housing scheme.
