Clerk informed Parish Councillors that the Quality Status certificate had been received

22/10 Matters arising

- ✓ Information on the grassed areas in the village maintained by the Parish Council as included with the last minutes. Councillors were concerned that the precept is being used to maintain land that is privately owned, Clerk to look for a resolution (Amended at the April meeting to include names of grassed areas being Old Lea and the land behind the Chapel)
- ✓ Information received reference grass cutting tender and S Atkinson's tender was accepted
- ✓ Cycle tracks in the village not possible due to lack of width on footpaths
- ✓ Burial Committee, Clerk to prepare draft cemetery rules and costs to present to the committee meeting on 12 April at 7.00pm in the Drop In Coffee Shop
- ✓ Affordable housing, still being discussed between land-owner and housing association
- ✓ Parish Council surgery at the Drop In on Saturday 13 March, interviews for litter pickers were also held
- ✓ War grave problem ongoing
- ✓ Green community, ongoing. A new School environment project is planned for the Autumn
- ✓ Highways, Cliffe Lane asked for passing places, waiting for a response. Clerk has reported many road defects and pot-holes
- ✓ Reference speeding information received for Selby Road and Back Lane, Clerk has written to Road Gritting Department at East Riding Council plus Police and Highways asking for the speeding information to be acted upon. The in depth figures to be discussed at the April meeting
- ✓ Chairman was successful in the application to attend a Royal Garden Party with a guest
- ✓ Salt bin applications, two bins have been sited
- ✓ Gallymoor roundabout, reply from the East Riding Council was not considered acceptable and Clerk to ask for another site meeting

- ✓ New takeaway fascia, waiting for feedback
- ✓ Map case on old school is to be moved next to notice-board

- Commuted sum £5000.00 ring fenced playing field drainage, an application is to be submitted
- Holme Christian Fellowship, £28.32 balance of grant awarded for broadband has now been claimed

27/10 Litter picker, the public were excluded for this agenda item. Five people were invited for interview, four people attended and one person has subsequently withdrawn. Chairman explained the interview process and fed back information from applicants. Parish Councillors unanimously **resolved** to offer the job to Peter Wiles, proposed S Hamilton seconded D Engall. Clerk to make arrangements to see Peter and make preparations for a 1 May 2010 start. Clerk also to progress taking responsibility from the East Riding Council for litter picking

28/10 Nominations for Parish Council representative on East Riding Council Standards Committee, Councillors unanimously **resolved** to nominate A Dowson, proposed C Worrall seconded D Engall

29/10 Reports

- All Councillors reported the poor state of village roads with pot-holes and road defects all over the village, Clerk to write to East Riding Council saying that something needs to be done urgently
- Two street-lights were reported as being out plus the willow tree on Springfield is still a problem
- A request for a litter bin on the Blacksmiths car park is to be discussed at the April meeting
- The side entrance road to the Church for horse and trap use is not good for cars, Clerk to ask the Church to keep this locked except when a horse and trap entrance is needed
- Clerk to check where the donated litter bin was sited plus door of litter bin at Port Royal needs attention
- Traffic warden service, need to determine when they attend the village
