

**Minutes of the Holme on Spalding Moor Parish Council meeting held on Wednesday 20  
February 2008 in the Methodist Church Hall**

Public session, there was no business

13/08 Minutes of the last meeting dated 16/01/08, these were approved and signed by the Chairman

Declaration of Interest,

The Parish Councils (Model Code of Conduct) Order 2001. To record any declarations of interest by any Member in respect of items on this agenda. S Appleyard on planning application DC/08/00352/PLF. R Templey on the proposed drop in centre, Councillors agreed that he would stay in the meeting to present the proposal for the drop in centre but leave if any voting were to take place.

14/08 Matters arising

Youth shelter and youth project, Chairman introduced and welcomed two guests, Paul Green and Emma Grimshaw. They explained that possible sites for a youth shelter had been investigated and the Village Hall car park was favoured for many reasons, it was believed that the Village Hall Committee was in favour of the proposal. A report was presented to Councillors and main points highlighted, it would need to be checked if planning permission would be needed. The Chairman thanked both guests for their attendance and information. R Templey then handed out copies of the proposal for a drop in centre and highlighted the main points, he expressed the view that he would like to see both proposals progressed. Chairman thanked him for the presentation. Councillors to discuss both issues again at the next meeting

The Chairman suggested that item 21/08 be brought forward in the agenda and Councillors agreed. 21/08 Holme Composters, the Clerk handed out copies of three communications received and gave Councillors updated information on the six Town/Parish Councils participating in the scheme. Councillors unanimously decided to accept Ward Councillor Fraser's offer to meet with the Parish Council to explain community composting and how it fits within the broader East Riding Council recycling Target 45+. Clerk to arrange a Special Parish Council meeting to fit in with Ward Councillor Fraser's diary

S Vicary joined the meeting

- Land adjacent to cul-de-sac Sand Hole, this land is not common land, it is not owned by the East Riding Council. Clerk to check ownership via the Land Registry and ask the East Riding Council Archives to look for ownership via the 1777 Enclosure Award
- Waiting for VMS signs decision, Clerk updated Councillors that a decision is expected soon following speed measurements, D Engall informed the meeting that 58 parishes had applied for a budgeted 25 available signs
- No waiting Runner End/Selby Road, consultation letters have been sent out, waiting for results
- Willow tree on village green, 3 quotes received for pruning and removal. Clerk read out a letter received, issue deferred until the next meeting

- Highways issues: Church gate, Clerk read out email response, to follow up and ask for a site visit. Stockhill road surface waiting on reply. Mini roundabout at Rush Corner works are programmed for April 2008
- Street lighting, survey results were discussed and Councillors decided to ask for Cliffe Lane lights to be attended to immediately and ask for further clarification on other problems. The streetlight problem on Springfield, action not considered necessary in foreseeable future
- Annual Christmas Fair, Ann Dowson gave details of monies raised and stated that the 2008 event planning had been started. The bucket collection in aid of the Fire Service raised £220.00
- Beechwood Services problem hedge, reply received from Drainage Board was read out. Clerk to write to East Riding Council asking for action on the hedge and the road junction
- Gallymoor, the new manager has offered to re-start the regular liaison meetings. This was seen as a better forum for discussion, the first meeting will be held on Thursday 28 February 2008
- Notice-board at west end of village, the East Riding Council has been requested to stain the whole board
- Damaged village entry sign, Chairman reported on a site meeting with the East Riding Council. The ERYC denies responsibility but has offered to meet half of the repair cost, Clerk has an insurance claim form to meet the other half of the cost. Chairman to arrange for the work to be completed and Clerk to ask the East Riding Council to trim the area in future in preference to using a lawnmower
- Litter problems, a letter detailing collection/picking arrangement was read out. Councillors will monitor effectiveness, Clerk to enquire whether a gum busting machine can be used in the village centre
- Enforcement issues, the reply from East Riding Council was noted
- Commuted sums, Chairman reported on a site meeting about the proposed Cherry Drive amenity area. Once follow up information has been received the consultation with residents will begin. Other schemes are ongoing
- Chairmans Awards, the two nominations submitted were noted
- Reports made on A163 road surface, drain outside Vicarage, drinking on the railway line and waiting for feedback
- S Atkinson has attended to the dog bin & litter bin problems. It was decided to wait for ownership resolution before tidying up the land at Sand Hole

15/08 Planning applications, D Engall observed but did not join in the discussions

DC/08/00352/PLF Erection of single storey extensions to side and rear at Bursea Grange, Bursea Lane for S Appleyard. S Appleyard left the meeting for discussion of this item. Councillors had no comments

DC/08/00283/PLF Erection of single storey extension to side (**Resubmission of 07/05429/PLF**) at Hasholme Carr, Drain Lane for Mr & Mrs G Morton. No comments

DC/08/00643/PLF Erection of single storey extension to rear at 69 High Street for Mr & Mrs Pickering. No comments

DC/08/00400/PLF Change of use to existing warehouse and workshop for use not in connection with nursery at Sands Lane Nurseries for Derek Arnold. Councillors objected to this retrospective application, it being an issue that has been complained about in the past. This is not an agricultural application and all such industry should be sited on the airfield. Clerk to ask the application to go to the planning committee

17/08 Accounts, balance £159.48 current account, £6787.31 saver account

Three cheques were approved for payment S Atkinson £110.00, Holme on Spalding Moor Village Hall Committee £125.00 and Rotherhams £430.14

Three cheques were received from A Dowson totalling £168.25 being income from the Christmas Fair Clerk advised that the District Auditor has been appointed

18/08 Newsletter update, Chairman reported that the newsletter was a year old and was showing a profit. The Clerk was getting more involved in the newsletter production, any balance of copies following delivery were being left in shops for people to pick up

19/08 No Cold Calling Zones, Clerk distributed information and it was decided to invite the East Riding Council Officer Jody Nightingale to the next meeting

20/08 Local Paths Partnership Scheme for 2008-09, Clerk handed the manual to A Dowson who agreed to look at the information with a view to progressing membership

21/08 Holme Composters, was discussed earlier in the meeting

22/08 HOSM Education in Need Charity. W Evans four years term has ended. M Johnson proposed R Templey seconded that the Chairman be the representative for the next four years, agreed unanimously

23/08 Reports

- Problems relating to Gallymoor were raised and noted for the liaison meeting
- Clerk to ask for action on the overgrown and muddy footpath on Howden Road between Port Royal crossroads and the garage on the east side
- Sue Ryder Home has asked if a pedestrian crossing could be arranged from the West Lodge entrance to allow people in wheelchairs to be transported across the road more safely
- The new speed limits were welcomed, Clerk to ask if 30mph repeaters could be put up along Howden Road. There also is no 40mph buffer zone from the Market Weighton entrance to the village. Clerk also to check the placement of the 40mph zone at Skiff Lane
- Duck Nest Farm, Clerk to contact Environment Agency to ask for action on the composting smells, many complaints received but no action has been taken
- Green Lane Public Right of Way from Baileywood to Howden Road is overgrown
- Salt Bins at Port Royal and bottom of Church Hill next to the cattle grid need replacing
