

MINUTES OF MEETING OF HOLME ON SPALDING MOOR PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON
WEDNESDAY 20TH JUNE AT 7.30PM IN THE METHODIST CHURCH HALL

Apologies. P.Cllr Vicary

2294

Declarations of Interest. P.Cllrs Johnson, Payne & Worrall declared an interest in planning Application of Mr & Mrs G Hawcroft, Cllr Worrall also declared an interest in planning application of Messrs. Rotherhams.

2295

Minutes. Minutes of previous meeting subject to 2288 (9) to read Humberside Police Traffic Office NOT "ER Traffic Officer" minutes accepted & signed.

2296

Matters Arising. 1. Mr David Wilson had passed away during the last month, several Parish Councillors & members of Village Hall Committee had attended funeral.

2297

Code of Conduct. Proposed Cllr Engall Sec. Cllr Worrall that Holme On Spalding Moor Parish adopts The Model Code of Conduct for Parish Council including paragraph 12 (2). This unanimously carried. The new Code of Conduct came into force from 3rd of May. Information re. "dual hated roles" was given, members of V Hall Committee etc will be able to discuss any items except financial when they would have to leave the meeting. Booklets re. Code of Conduct given to all Cllrs.

Pocklington M.W. Area Forum. Cllr Engall proposed that Cllr Worrall be nominated for the election to this Forum. There were no further nominations and Cllr Worrall agreed his name should go forward. Clerk explained that all Parish Cllrs will receive voting papers through the post for them to return direct to ERYC.

2299

Streetscene. Cllr Worrall gave report on village streetscene walk which he and Cllr Evans had attended. Gulley cleaning, seat painting, highway signs etc had been highlighted. Rush Corner road surface & Port Royal footpath had been noted but these are capital schemes and will be notified to the appropriate section.

Correspondence. 1. Letter & photos from Mr Waudby, Hawthorne Drive re. bad behaviour & drinking on amenity area to rear of chapel. Clerk to inform PCSO about this. Clerk to place on agenda for discussion at July meeting best way forward for Parish Council to deal with this land to claim ownership. ERYC to be asked to designate this a no drinking area. Prop Cllr Hamilton Sec Cllr Worrall & all agreed that clerk write to ERYC & ask for guidance on first steps to reclaiming ownership.
2. Letter from Mr Rotherham re. accident caused by speed & adverse camber at Tollingham Cottages bend, Skiff Lane. Speed limits for this lane are in pipeline. Clerk to write to Dave Bragg re, road camber, also contact police about speeding young motorists along this area, Drain Lane, Bursea Lane & also Spen Lane & to ask for more regular police presence.
3. Howden weight limit. Letter received from ERYC, response time had been extended. Clerk read copy of letter she had written from HOSM P.Council. copies of letters from Foggathorpe PC, Bubwith PC & Cllr P.Robinson were noted & on file. Cllr Engall gave a report of what has happened so far, a large number of names have been gathered on the petition.
4. Request for nomination for a Parish Cllr to sit on the Standards Board for ER. No offers were forthcoming.
5. HWRCC request for nominations to this Board. No names offered.
6. HWRCC Calor Village of the Year Competition, HOSM is in final seven. Judges will attend on Friday 29th June 2007 at 2.30pm. It will be a 2 hour visit. They will attend the school, ride

round the village & see the displays by Clubs, Churches & Groups about what is offered by them for residents.

7. ERYC letter with disc re. Draft Rights of Way Improvement Plan available for Cllrs.
8. Notification of tree felling to take place at Meadowfield noted.
9. Acknowledgement of letter to police re. youth activity on land at Moor End, clerk to write & inform Mr Arminson about what is taking place on his land.
10. Letter from ER Planning that Mr Hawcroft had informed them that Parish Council had been consulted with incorrect plans for discussion at April meeting. Clerk gave assurance that she had displayed plans as received 29th March 2007.
11. Letter from Lionel Lennox re. consecration of cemetery. Cllr Worrall had received information from Church Warden that there is 6 years space left in Church graveyard. Clerk to write to Canon Cox to ascertain what space there is left in the Roman Catholic Graveyard.

Erection of extension to existing workshop at J. Rotherham Masonry, Holme Ind Estate. P.Cllrs recommended approval. Developments on Ind Estate to be encouraged as they bring employment into the area.

Cllrs Worrall, Johnson, Payne & Williamson declared an interest in the following item & left meeting. Cllr Engall remained in Chair.

Skiff Lane, for G.A.Hawcroft.

Support individual persons building special designs of housing.

It is not overlooking anyone else.

Is client not able to decide a building is beyond repair & to build new is best option?

Building felt too large & not in keeping with the surrounding area.

Recommend approval. Votes 4 in favour, 2 abstentions, 1 against.

P.Cllrs returned to meeting. Cllr Worrall resumed in Chair. Cllr Smith said that in almost 40 years as Parish Councillor he had not known interests to be declared in this way. Cllr Worrall said that 3 P.Cllrs who had been telephoned several times by applicant did not wish to appear to public to have been influenced in this way therefore declared an interest & took no part in discussion or vote. 4th P.Cllr is relative of applicant.

Reports.

1. Rush Corner flood, Beacon View Tree, road surface opposite Weir pond, all have been previously reported & noted by ERYC.
2. Re-instatement of church gate entrance at side of cattle grid to be requested to allow horse drawn vehicles to access. Clerk to write to ER Highways.
3. Clerk to report gravelling of garden encroaching onto footpath, 1 Port Royal.
4. Ditch at front of New Police House, clerk to advise householder to contact MWDBD re. potting of same.
5. Cllr Engall reported in strategic planning meeting planned for Thursday with reference to Gallymoor application. She confirmed that the mixture to come out of the plant will be useable, spreadable compost which will be offered to local farmers. HOSM P.Council observations were read out again. Some amendments had been made to traffic issues. Everingham P.C. had made no observations. A liaison committee has been formed.

7. Grass cutter has demolished sign near Kingfisher, ERYC are aware of this.
8. 2 Litter bins have been donated & will be sited on the playing fields.
