

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF HOLME ON SPALDING MOOR PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON

Declarations. All Parish Councillors elected at the May 2007 Parish Council election had signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office and were welcomed to the meeting by Chairman Cllr. Worrall. All P.Cllrs had received various items from the clerk including booklet on being a Councillor as well as Register of Interest Forms to be returned to the clerk.

Interests. Cllr Worrall declared an interest in his own planning application to be discussed later on agenda. No other interests were declared.

Cllr Worrall Sec Cllr Templey that we spend £1200 this year, this for 3 lights at full price or 4 if we are able to take advantage of 60/40 scheme. Unanimously agreed. Clerk will put request in writing. Cllr Hamilton offered to provide a safe, risk assessment method statement for clerk to send to Mr Tennant, ERYC.
