There are concerns at greatly increase numbers of tractors &amp; trailers through the village carrying waste to the spreading sites with the obnoxious odours this creates. These odours are unacceptable to local residents. Increased lorry numbers bringing waste to be composted at the sites are unacceptable. There have been petitions from villagers with reference to smells in the past. There are 2 dwellings on the site at Prospect Farm &amp; Not 1, also there are 3 dwellings at Workshouse Cottages. There are a number if dwellings within 250 therefore Cllrs feel the 250m rule comes into effect. P Cllrs note there is very little mention of liquid waste in the planning documents, more information is required on this. Proximity rule should apply. There is no environmental impact on the site mentioned in planning documents.
