

MINUTES OF HOLME ON SPALDING MOOR PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON
WEDNESDAY 21ST MARCH 2007 AT 7.30PM IN THE METHODIST CHURCH HALL.

Minutes. Minutes of previous meeting having been circulated were approved & signed.

Matters Arising. 1. As approved at last meeting, Cllr Wild had taken Planning Application from Allensway Recycling to read more thoroughly. He advised that this should be read in conjunction with the previous application of April 2007. In first application it is for two sheds, 1 for delivery and 1 for processing. Latest plans has 4 sheds on site, states all will be fitted with bio filters. Page 5 (425) says all operations will take place in sheds & will vent through bio filters on each shed. Latest site plan reception shed is outside the red marked site plan.

P.Cllrs feel over producing is taking place on site.

Resolved clerk to write to ERYC Planning and give these comments.

Copy to Environment Agency. Environment Agency also to be asked to check what is going though the site & point out a lagoon has appeared since P.Cllrs made their site visit.

Building work is going on & many tons of compost being buried, concerns expressed over environmental impact.

P.Cllrs comments

Parish Council are concerned at possible obnoxious odours from this site. The whole ideas of Holme On Spalding Moor becoming a public tipping & composting area is unacceptable. The cumulative impact of this site, together with the 3 on farm composting sites in one parish is totally unacceptable. Holme On Spalding Moor Parish Council recommends a Public Enquiry into the whole question is set up without delay. HOSM Parish Council strongly objects this proposal & recommends refusal.

Chairman reported that a liaison group has been set up between P.Cllrs, residents, Environment Agency & Waste Recycling Group to resolve issues of concern. First meeting reported, drivers will be instructed to approach site via Shiptonthorpe Lane.

Resolved that a petition against Waste Recycling sites in Holme On Spalding Moor be set up. Agreed.
